

## Expected Learning Outcomes

### Latin Stage 1: Foundations I Course 357

#### Standard #

Interprets the dictionary entry of a Latin noun, adjective, or verb, in order to tell what declension or conjugation the word belongs to, and other relevant information.

Writes, or chooses, the correct form of a Latin word, in the context of a sentence, according to certain grammatical rules and categories.

Translates Latin sentences into English, using certain vocabulary and grammatical patterns.

Reads aloud, with accurate pronunciation and appropriate expression, the stories referred to above.
